

Number of doctorate holders, in Greece and the other survey countries⁶





Doctorate holders (%) by region and country of doctoral award










Employed doctorate holders (%) (employees, self-employed) by occupation (ISCO-08)

Employed doctorate holders (%) by level of satisfaction with their employment



Unemployed doctorate holders (%) in 2013 by year of doctoral award (1990 -2013)






Researchers in Greece Mobility

% National citizens with a doctorate








Researchers in Greece Mobility

Previous country of stay for mobile doctorate holders having returned or arrived in Greece








Researchers in Greece Mobility





Incoming Researchers* Hosted by AUTH for per H2020 Funding Programme (2015-2018)







EL fellows (nationals) grouped by country of destination (top 10 countries)



Number of AUTH MSCA Projects (2015-2018) Total: 17








MSCA projects and mobility-AUTH

Number of MSCA Projects per School of AUTH (2015-2018)








