#### 1. Brief history of Greek Network EURAXESS 1/2

➤ <u>Set-up:</u> The Greek Network EURAXESS (formerly Network ERA-MORE) consists of 15 members and is part of the European Network EURAXESS. CERTH, as coordinator of the network, has created and maintains the National Researcher's Mobility Portal (<a href="http://www.euraxess.gr">http://www.euraxess.gr</a>)



#### 1. Brief history of Greek Network EURAXESS 2/2

➤ The Greek Network was launched in 2003 with 10 members and during its more than 15 years of operation, only one member withdrew while six new members have been added. Therefore, the network now consists of 15 members.

➤ The network is now fully operational, having served more than 6,500 mobile researchers and more than 35,000 visitors visited the portal in recent years
